We are an Indigenous Agency that is dedicated to strengthening the lives and voices of Indigenous people and we are looking for a Caregiver Support Person to join our compassionate, respectful, and caring team.

Nezul Be Hunuyeh Child and Family Services is an Indigenous Child & Family Service agency serving the communities of Nak'azdlii Whut'en, Binche Whut'en and Tl'azt'en Nation. We recognize that Nezul Be Hunuyeh's head office is located on the shores of Nak'al bun (Stuart Lake) on the Nak'azdli Territorial Lands of the Dakelh People. Our Agency offers inclusivity, opportunities for growth, and for Cultural Learning.

In the Caregiver Support position, you will be that familiar face, the expert resource in welcoming caregivers into the community, providing them with a sense of belonging, and making them feel like welcomed and valued members of the caregiver's community team. Every day you'll be making a meaningful contribution by facilitating and encouraging access to vital resources and tools helping caregivers to succeed and thrive in their role with children and youth from our communities.

Key areas of responsibility

- ✚ To be a point of contact for individuals and/or families who are caregivers, for a family member, a friend or for children and youth who need placement.
- ✚ To provide support services and encourage caregivers to access these services.
- ✚ Through regular contact, support caregivers to identify areas where they, or the children in their care need additional supports or services and assist in developing strategies to meet these needs.
- ✚ To identify and access community resources to provide support to the caregiver homes when required, including referrals to other community programs and professionals.
- ✚ To collaborate with Nezul Be Hunuyeh staff and other community services to assist in providing support to caregivers.
- ✚ To assist with recruitment for caregiver homes in community.
- ✚ To be available by phone, email or in person to offer all caregivers an avenue for support while caring for children from our member Nations.
- ✚ To operate within Nezul Be Hunuyeh's vision, mandate, policy, and standards.

The Successful Applicant will:

- ✚ Reflect and interpret the Agency Vision, Mission, and Core values in his/her own work with commitment and respect.
- ✚ Have knowledge of Dakelh Culture and the communities we serve.
- ✚ Work independently and collaboratively to build effective relationships with the caregivers and colleagues.
- ✚ Be willing to work flexible hours due to the nature of the work.
- ✚ A strong background in Indigenous Social Work knowledge of customary care and the philosophy of service development and delivery, the communities and the family's structure.
- ✚ A diploma in social or human services is preferred, however, a combination of education and employment experience will be considered.
- ✚ Indigenous ancestry will be an asset
